A new stage in the Gospel begins today, marked off by the first words *On the way to Jerusalem*. And as on Sunday 21 the theme is the openness of the Kingdom to all the people of the world, not just the chosen people. The story of Naaman the Syrian in 1R, a Gentile cured of leprosy by following the instructions of Elisha the prophet, has already been raised by Jesus on the 4th Sunday, when the congregation of the synagogue was roused to anger by it and threatened to kill him. Naaman was very grateful and made repeated attempts to reward Elisha, which he refused to accept. The psalm accentuates the universal embrace by of all people by God. In the Gospel we have a real life repetition of the Naaman event. Jesus is walking ‘along the border between Samaria and Galilee’ when he came upon a group of ten lepers coming meet him. Lepers were unclean (see Leviticus 13:38-46) and had to live apart. Jesus does not approach them but tells them to go and see the priests, who can declare them clean. only one of them, finding himself cured, praises God at the top of his voice, like Naaman, turns back to Jesus and throws himself at his feet and thanks him. He is a Samaritan, a ‘foreigner’, with whom Jews do not associate. But Jesus is the Lord of all peoples and associates with whom he will. • 2R concludes with a famous passage which may be a hymn. . (*The Liturgy Planner*)
