If there is one thing we don't like, it's uncertainty. We know that our lives will end; we even know vaguely that the world will end, but when? God knows; in the second case (because it is possible to cause your own death, or receive a death sentence, and we would get warning of a nuclear strike), only God. In fact as Jesus sets it out, his second coming, like Noah's flood, will happen within some people's lifetimes, and there was some expectation among the first Christians that it would be within theirs. Jesus night have told us, but explicitly ruled this out, and all attempts to say 'the end is nigh' and predict the Day and the Hour have failed and will continue to do so. This Gospel pasage comes from the end of Matthew 24, and the preceding verses give mandetail of the End which lead to endlessss speculation. We must live with uncertainty, in a state of permanent wakefulness. St Paul who seems to hint at an early return by Jesus spells out what this means in terms of behaviour: no drunken orgies, no promiscuity, no wrangling or jealousy. Apart from the last two, this doesn't seem too much to ask. We would be ashamed to admit to the others and prefer to keep quiet about them. In any case we are headed to a place of joy, whether it is the house of the Lord (psalm) or the mountain of the Lord (1R). Let us therefore stay awake and stand ready. (The Liturgy Planner)
