Keep my soul in peace before you, O Lord

Gospel acclamation

Speak, Lord, your servant is listening: you have the message of eternal life.

Last week was the conclusion of Jesus's arguments with people who wish him ill, and this week he turns to 'the people and his disciples.' Matthew's controversies with the Pharisees have a historical basis; around the time he was writing his Gospel (in the 70s-80s AD) a council of Pharisees was debating the relationship between Judaism and the young Christian church. But the strictures that Jesus directs against the scribes and pharisees are valid at any time as an attack on empty religious observance. There have been such people in the Church at every period of history, and no doubt in Matthew's time too. Clergy are particularly visible culprits in this but they are an easy target, and anyone can be mean-spirited, which is another way of saying pharisaical. The first reading is a prophet's attack on bad priests of his time. They had created divisions, and this is a betrayal of the unity of the human race as God intended it. The Psalm is a way of expressing humility, and just by expressing it one can learn to be what we sing. It may be that our heart actually is proud and we don't want to consider ourselves as the least (as in the Gospel). Look at the scriptures today in the light of what Paul says in 2R: God's message and not some human thinking. LITURGY PLANNER
