The Holy Trinity is not an explicit doctrine in Scripture. In the Old Testament there is not even a doctrine of Christ. What there is, and this is expressed in the 1R and Psalm, is a strong, almost fierce, assertion of the oneness and greatness of God and his care for his people - as in the first two of the Ten Commandments, as seen in the concluding words of 1R; where in the Psalm the same things are said from the viewpoint of the people. And yet even in the Old Testament there are intimations of the Trinity; the Spirit of God is there at creation in Genesis 1, and the Messiah, the saviour, is foretold in various ways in the prophets, to say nothing of the frequent references to 'the word of the Lord' as in the first line of the Psalm. In the New Testament 'the Trinity' is not spoken of but as it is the story of the Son of God, a man who is worshipped as God after showing his divinity in many ways, until he rises from the dead, and who promises to send the Holy Spirit. At the very end of Matthew's Gospel, heard today, Jesus finally uses the words *in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit* whereas Paul in Romans, written before the Gospel, talks of the Spirit, the Father and our status as children of God and co-heirs with Christ. The Trinity is seen as action, not something static to sit and contemplate. This action is something we are involved in too: we have to go and make disciples of all nations. LITURGY PLANNER
