The Gospel begins with the final words from last week, in which Jesus extended the claim to be the Living Bread to calling it 'my flesh, for the life of the world'. Then, as anticipated, the questioning begins. The people take the words literally. Jesus, as before, does not answer their question but repeats his original phrase, and expands them to include drinking blood as well. If anyone is offended by these words, it should not be us, as they are uttered every day at Mass. In the words of consecration we say 'body' rather than 'flesh', as in the Last Supper accounts. But John does not have these words in his Last Supper account, and some have suggested that this chapter fulfils the same function, representing the words used at the Eucharist in John's community. Verse 58 repeats words already spoken, particularly v. 51 which begins today's passage, and this concludes the discourse. The consequences are to be seen next week. To find an OT parallel the Lectionary turns to the book of Proverbs. These words are taken from an extended passage extolling Wisdom and contrasting her (she is personified with folly and ignorance.) We might feel affronted by the implication that we are fools if we are invited to a feast of bread and wine, but many people do see us in that way. We know though that what people see as God's folly is in fact true wisdom. Liturgy planner.

Niech to Słowo przemienia nasze serca, abyśmy jeszcze bardziej otworzyli się na Bożą Mądrość i Jego wolę. WIARA.PL
