The fact of a 1R from the beginning of Genesis means that something of great importance is to be said. Today is no exception: the story of the origin of marriage. This is the second account of the creation of woman, but Jesus uses the words from the first (Gen 1:27), *God made them male and female*. To say this is controversial territory is an understatement. Pope Francis's letter *Amoris laetitia*, intended to sum up the synods on the family, has given rise to serious opposition among those who think he is weakening the doctrine of marriage. But its opening words: *The joy of love experienced by families is also the joy of the Church* are surely the way to approach the readings today. *Families are not a problem; they are first and foremost an opportunity* (AL6) is another. If we concentrate on Jesus' words about divorce we will not be true to the infinite benefits of love and the family on which so much human happiness depends. And yet human sadness must be recognised, even by the happily married. An assurance of support from the community is essential if people who through bad luck or their own fault have experienced marital breakdown are not to feel unwelcome and excluded. Another aspect of the Gospel today is Jesus's brush with the Pharisees; he is abrogating a decree of Moses, which would not be received sympathetically. Liturgy planner.
