Remembrance Sunday

This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday. We remember those who fought in the “great” wars of the 20th C, and pray for the repose of the souls of the fallen.

Let us pray for peace in our own day too. 🙏 The Holy Father’s Encyclical, *Fratelli Tutti* (“all brothers”; Oct 2020) drew our attention to how there is a pressing need to cultivate “fraternity and social friendship” in today’s world, in which many factors tend to lead to isolation, abandonment, opposition (cf. FT 6).

Some of us might remember the difficult years in which the Second Vatican Council made this heartfelt appeal: “the Council wishes passionately to summon Christians to cooperate, under the help of Christ the author of peace, with all men in securing among themselves a peace based on justice and love and in setting up the instruments of peace” (Gaudium et Spes 77). The needs of today don’t seem so very different.

True peace is founded on “the peace of Christ which radiates from God the Father” (GS 78), and is God’s gift to us through Christ’s sacrifice on the cross. But we must do our part. “In order to build up peace above all the causes of discord among men, especially injustice, which foment wars must be rooted out” (GS 83).
