Station Mass

All Banff parishioners are warmly invited to attend the Lent Station Mass at Our Lady's Church, Fraserburgh,* on Friday 4th April at 6:30pm! <u>We're delighted to</u> welcome Bishop Hugh to preside at this Station Mass!

What's a "station Mass"? The term goes back to Christian-Roman antiquity, when the Pope, the Bishop of Rome, would celebrate Mass on specific days at particular churches in or around Rome. The gatherings often involved a procession to the church. In Lent they were marked by fasting and special prayers, which were seen as part of one's Christian service or duty, rather like that of soldiers who remained attentive at their posts (*statio*) when on duty. For this reason, the churches in which these papal Masses were celebrated came to be known as "Stations".

Today, we gather during Lent at designated churches in our deanery with Bishop Hugh. It's an opportunity to celebrate our common faith, encourage one another, and ask for God's blessings as we undertake a programme of Lenten renewal.

Why Rejoice in Lent?

This Sunday is Laetare Sunday. Laetare is a Latin word meaning "Rejoice". It comes from the entrance antiphon at Mass which is based on Isaiah 66:10: "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her..." Jerusalem, the city of God, symbolises the people of God, the Church. We are all called to rejoice today, because we can look back with gratitude for the help God has given us up to now, and we can look forward in hope to the full effects of His merciful love in our lives. God has shown us His love especially in the Passion of Christ. He now asks us to follow Him, and to trust Him at all times. In this way He will lead us to share in the joy and power of the Resurrection!
