Lobby Against Assisted Suicide. From the Catholic Parliamentary Office: You may recall that on 13th May, MSPs narrowly voted through Liam McArthur's Assisted Dying for Terminally III Adults (Scotland) Bill, by 70 votes to 56. The Bill is expected to return to Parliament in the coming

To coincide with this, SPUC (Society for the Protection of Unborn Children), will be holding a mass lobby of MSPs on Tuesday 7th October, between 10am - 3pm. The aim of a mass lobby is for as many people as possible to go into parliament on the same day to lobby their MSPs. It is a very effective way of engaging with MSPs and making your views known.
